CAMPUS RECREATION:

Monkeypox Prevention Recommendations for Arts and Athletics with Shared Studios and Equipment

- Establish clear cleaning protocols for equipment, rooms, and surfaces.
 - Include sanitizing and equipment wipe down after use.
- Offer hand sanitizer to audiences/visitors, staff, and artists.
- Encourage patrons to wear more clothing to cover exposed skin.
- On a frequent basis during a performance, clean restrooms and wipe down high-touch surfaces.
 - If applicable, prohibit touching of exhibits.
- Use products from EPA List Q for Tier 1 viruses according to the instructions on the product label
- Patrons should sanitize equipment and wipe down after use.
- Disinfect floors and shared equipment prior to every class or rehearsal.

It is recommended that floors be cleaned once a day, as usual, followed by a sanitization using a disinfectant. If using a reusable mop pad, wash with bleach in a washing machine between uses.

PERFORMANCE VENUE:

Monkeypox Prevention Recommendations

(including athletic, theater and other events)

- In places where payments need to occur, such as concession stands, no-contact payment plat forms could be used.
- Theaters may plan to transition away from paper tickets and move as many audience communication materials as possible (i.e. programs) to a digital format.
- Reduce the use of shared objects and surfaces.
