The California Health and Safety Code requires that all UC Irvine employees receive an annual notification regarding the presence of asbestos in campus buildings constructed prior to 1979. Please review the notification here:

Asbestos is a naturally occurring group of fibrous minerals that were used extensively in building materials in the past, including in some buildings on the UC Irvine campus.

UC Irvine takes the management of asbestos on campus very seriously. The presence of asbestos does not mean that you have been exposed. Generally, intact and undisturbed asbestos-containing materials do not pose an immediate health risk. To manage the risk of exposure, the campus has developed an asbestos management plan, which is [available on the EHS website](#).
